

DEBARMENT AND SUSPENSION FROM RECEIPT OF FEDERAL ASSISTANCE STATEMENT FOR 4-YEAR NROTC APPLICATION (EXECUTIVE ORDER 12549, DEBARMENT AND SUSPENSION)

On February 18, 1986, Executive Order (EO) 12549, Debarment and Suspension, authorized establishing a government-wide system for excluding, in appropriate cases, individuals and legal entities from participating in Federal financial and nonfinancial assistance programs and activities.

The General Services Administration (GSA) is assigned responsibility for developing, maintaining and distributing a list of persons excluded from nonprocurement programs.

The list indicates participants who are debarred, suspended or voluntarily excluded from programs and activities involving Federal financial and nonfinancial assistance and benefits under EO 12549.

Transactions covered by this rule include, but are not limited to:

Nonprocurement transactions between an agency and a person, including grants, corporation agreements, scholarships, fellowships, contracts of assistance, loans, loan guarantees, etc.

The Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps (NROTC) scholarships fall under this rule. A person currently debarred or suspended from receiving Federal financial assistance is not eligible to apply for the NROTC College Scholarship Program.
