Dear Parents or Guardians,

The St. Amant High School Naval Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (NJROTC) is one of the most successful JROTC programs in the state of Louisiana. The NJROTC program is a citizenship and leadership development program that instills discipline, self-motivation, honor, courage, and commitment into your child's life. Freshmen taking the NJROTC class (Naval Science 1) at St. Amant High School also may take Health with the Naval Science Instructors. Students who are enrolled in NJROTC will receive a Physical Education credit their freshman year and an elective credit for all subsequent Naval Science classes. Students who take Naval Science classes and attend the Mini Boot Camp are required to have a **sports physical**, since the level of physical activity is moderately strenuous. The forms (Health Risk Screening Form, NJROTC Standard Release Form and LHSAA Sports Physical Form) required are available at our web site <http://www.stamantnjrotc.org>, and are included with this letter.

Our records indicate that your child selected, as one of their electives, Naval Science I and is invited to participate in our summer Mini Boot Camp program. The St Amant NJROTC Cadet Corps offers a Mini Boot camp that is held just prior to the start of school. Mini Boot Camp is not mandatory for NJROTC students, but it does allow your child to be a step ahead of the rest of his/her fellow classmates. Mini Boot Camp is a camp that is run by the upper classmen in the cadet corps. During this camp, which will be held July 25th thru July 29th (07:45 til 4pm daily), the cadets will learn basic military drill, teamwork, and basic Naval Science knowledge. The cost of Mini Boot Camp is \$35. For the cadets that participate in Mini Boot Camp, they will be allowed to take their first advancement test two weeks prior to their classmates. Mini Boot Camp is a fun and interesting camp for the cadets, it will put them steps ahead of the rest of the freshmen who don't attend. If your child is interested in attending our Mini Boot Camp, you can register by mail or email. When you register by mail include the \$35.00 fee and the students T-shirt and short sizes (adult sizes). Those registering by email can either mail the check to St Amant NJROTC or drop it by the Student Office prior to the start of camp. Checks should be made out to "St Amant High School". Additionally, payments can be made through the online receipting system. Identify your payment by selecting "**NJROTC Mini Boot Camp Fee**".

Mini Boot Camp is conducted during Prep week. Cadets will attend their scheduled Prep Day activities, at the completion of which they will return to the Mini Boot Camp activities.
